### **Some things to keep in mind when registering:**

- If your child will be in the same club as last year (ie. Cubbies, Sparks, or T&T) and already has the uniform, then you do not need to purchase another one.
- If your child is in Sparks or T&T and has not completed their Handbook (Workbooks excluded), then you do not need to purchase another book. Your child will keep their current Handbook and continue in it this fall.
- If your child will be advancing to the next club level (ie. Sparks or T&T), then you will need to purchase a Handbook and uniform.
- Verify that all forms are complete.
- PLEASE SUBMIT ALL FORMS TO THE CHURCH OFFICE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

### **Required Fees**

- Dues \$15 for the year or \$.50 per week
- Books \$10
- Vests for Cubbies or Sparks \$10.
- Shirts for Truth and Training \$15.
- Bags are \$10 each and are optional.
- Payments should be made out to **Citrus Park Ministries** and submitted when you register.

Club Registration is per child, \$15 dues per year or \$.50 per week. Each child is required to have a book at \$10 and a uniform for all Clubbers is \$10. We never want cost to be an issue of a child not being able to participate. Please see a club director or the commander if cost is an issue. Optional club handbook bags are available. See club secretary for details.

Club Times are Wednesdays from 6:30 – 8:00 p.m. Please have your children here 15 minutes early for check in.

**Term and Conditions for Participation in Citrus Park Ministries AWANA Clubs:**

- 1) I understand that my child may participate in physical activities such as those held during game time. As with any physical activity there is a risk of injury. I fully accept this risk and hold harmless from any legal liability CPM and any persons involved in the AWANA ministry.
- 2) I give consent for a volunteer at CPM to administer first aid in case of minor emergency.
- 3) In the event of an emergency that requires medical treatment for the above named child, I understand every effort will be made to contact me or my emergency contact. However, if I cannot be reached, I give permission to the AWANA volunteer to secure necessary medical care to provide the care necessary for my child's well being. I assume responsibility for all costs connected to any accident or treatment of my child.
- 4) I give my permission for my child to attend and participate in activities sponsored by CPM. This includes occasional off campus activities.
- 5) I grant permission for a photo of my child to used in promotion of the CPM AWANA program or published on the CPM Facebook page.
- 6) I will pick up and drop off my child myself or through the designated persons above according to the specified timelines. I understand that CPM is not responsible for early drop off or late pick up.
- 7) I have read the parents information packet and gone over rules and guidelines with my child - including not picking up my child early so they can take full advantage of the nightly schedule and **wearing sturdy footwear each club night.**
- 8) I give my permission for my child to ride with an AWANA leader for any off campus field trips. If my child requires a car seat I agree to provide the car seat or attend the field trip and transport my own child.
